



# ClassDojo

You might have heard your child talking about *Dojo* points, or indeed, they may have brought home a certificate, so we would like to take this opportunity to tell you a little about it, what dojos are, and how they are used in St Cyrus School.

*ClassDojo* is being used throughout the school to reward children for demonstrating a range of skills such as good listening; being kind and helpful; working hard; and tidying up. The categories can be chosen by each teacher with their class as they feel appropriate.

Each child has a fun monster themed character that can be awarded *Dojo* points by any adult working within the school. Points are allocated on a smartboard screen and can be seen (and heard) by everyone in the class when they are awarded. As well as being awarded to individuals, *Dojo* points can also be awarded to groups or the whole class at one time.

Each class has an agreed point at which a pupil's collection of points is recognised and rewarded with a certificate or other agreed activity. At the point of this award being made, for example a certificate home for 40 *Dojos* collected, then the points are set back to zero and your child starts collecting again.

*Dojo* points are a great way for us to celebrate a variety of good behaviours in school and to let children share their successes with you at home. Why not ask your child to show you their little monster when you're in class?
